Reports from the Bishop's Committee for November

Bishop's Committee
November 2, 2025
Minutes

Present: Fr. Chandler Jackson, Rob Barns, George Keller, Jennifer Marbut, Betty Gloyd.

Fr. Jackson opened the meeting at 11:03 with a prayer and historical ideas about All Soul's Day.

Reports

Secretary - Rob moved and George seconded that the minutes of the October 5 meeting be approved. Motion passed.

Treasurer - The October financial report was presented. George moved and Betty seconded that the financial report be accepted. Motion passed. George began a discussion about the expense balance vs. the budgeted amount. It looks like we will be ok. The income balance vs the budgeted amount looks like we will break even or be a little ahead at the end of the year.

Donations for the Marion Medical Mission is at \$1100. Jennifer and Rob will work on the grant application for matching funds from the diocese.

Warden - Rob commented that he and Lisa had been at Least of These, assisting in packing Thanksgiving meals. A total of 1600 meals were packed for distribution. Another time of packing meals, for Christmas, will be November 17. Least of These has had 300 new families sign up for assistance in the past month.

Priest – The Diocesan Clergy Conference was this past week in Branson. The theme was clergy wellness – physical, spiritual, and emotional. I received some great information. On Wednesday, the bishop talked about changes in the diocese. Archdeacon Bruce Bower is retiring after convention. Also, the two chaplains to the retired clergy are also retiring. The Rev Ron Keel will be the new chaplain for the retired clergy.

The bishop also discussed the issue of “tiny cups” for communion. Liturgically, there is no biblical precedent for the use of individual cups for communion. It is recommended that we explore either intinction from the common cup or a separate “intinction cup” for those uncomfortable with drinking from the common cup. This is not something we need to change immediately, so we will continue to discuss how St. Matt’s will handle this.

I will be gone the end of the week for Diocesan Convention in Kansas City. I will go up on Thursday to work in the archives and assist in setting up for the convention. I will return Saturday evening. There are many elections to be held this year, so the convention business session on Saturday could be long.

Old Business: Bazaar wrap-up – We took in approximately \$850 this year. Rob moved and George seconded a motion to hold the money in the General Fund until after the first of the year. Then we can reassess where to use it best.

Update of the grant for ad – Rob is in contact with the people at the newspaper. We decided that the ad should include the Episcopal Shield, the name of the church, service times, physical address, phone number, website, email, and Facebook, Wednesday dinners, and Adult Education. The people at the paper will create the ad and send it to Rob for approval.

New Business: None.
